| Arrowwood | 12 – 18" | 8' x 5' | High | M | Mod | White flowers. Blue-black fruit. <i>Viburnum dentatum</i> |
| Birch, Paper | 12 – 18" | 60' x 40' | Low | M - D | Fast | Prefers well-drained sandy loam. <i>Betula papyrifera</i> |
| Cedar, White | 8 – 16" | 40' x 20' | Med | W - M | Slow | Plant in clay loams to sandy loams. <i>Thuja occidentalis</i> |
| Chokecherry | 12 – 18" | 15' x 12' | Med | D - M | Mod | Tart, edible fruit. <i>Prunus virginiana</i> |
| Crabapple, Red Splendor * | 12 – 18" | 20' x 20' | Low | M - D | Mod | Pink, rose, or white blossoms. <i>Malus species</i> |
| Cranberry, Highbush | 12 – 18" | 16' x 16' | Med | M | Mod | Tart, edible fruit. <i>Viburnum trilobum</i> |
| Dogwood, Red Osier | 12 – 18" | 8' x 6' | High | W - M | Mod | Red stems. Winter color, food for deer. <i>Cornus sericea</i> |
| Elderberry, Common | 12 – 18" | 9' x 9' | Med | M - D | Fast | Prefers loamy moist soil. Favorite of songbirds. Makes wine & jelly. <i>Sambucus canadensis</i> |
| Hazelnut, American | 12 – 18" | 8' x 8' | Med | M | Mod | Edible nuts. <i>Corylus americana</i> |
| Juneberry | 12 – 18" | 8' x 8' | Med | M - D | Mod | Suckers. Edible fruit. <i>Amelanchier alnifolia</i> |
| Lilac, Common* | 12 – 18" | 12' x 12' | Low | M - D | Mod | Purple flowers. Suckers. <i>Syringa vulgaris</i> |
| Maple, Red | 12 – 18" | 50' x 40' | Med | M - W | Mod | Red to yellow in fall. <i>Acer rubrum</i> |
| Maple, Silver | 12 – 18" | 70' x 70' | Low | M - W | Fast | Excellent for habitat. Yellow fall color. <i>Acer saccharinum</i> |
| Maple, Sugar | 12 – 18" | 60' x 50' | High | M | Mod | Syrup, bright fall colors. <i>Acer saccharum</i> |
| Nanking Cherry* | 12—20" | 8' x 8' | Low | M | Mod | White flowers, green foliage with edible red fruit. <i>Prunus Tomentosa</i> |
| Nannyberry | 12 – 18" | 15' x 6' | Med | M - D | Fast | Edible fruit after frost. Good for birds. <i>Viburnum lentago</i> |
| Oak, Bur | 12 – 18" | 60' x 40' | Med | W - D | Slow | Prefers moist well-drained soil but will grow in other areas. Mast, firewood, saw logs. <i>Quercus macrocarpa</i> |
| Oak, Red | 12 – 18" | 60' x 40' | Med | M | Fast | Prefers well-drained rich moist soils. Mast, firewood, sawlogs. <i>Quercus rubra</i> |
| Pine, Red (Norway) | 12 – 24" | 60' x 25' | Low | D - M | Fast | Susceptible to salt damage. MN State Tree. <i>Pinus resinosa</i> |
| Pine, White | 8 – 16" | 80' x 40' | Med | M | Fast | Prefers well-drained moist loam & silty loam. <i>Pinus strobus</i> |
| Plum, American | 12 – 18" | 20' x 15' | Low | M - D | Fast | Edible red/yellow fruit. <i>Prunus americana</i> |
| Prairie Rose | 10—20" | 2' x 2' | Low | M - D | Mod | Sun to part shade; fields, and along edges of woods. <i>Rosa Arkansa</i> |
| Spruce, Black | 5 – 12" | 50' x 20' | High | W - D | Slow | Excellent for wildlife cover or shelter belts. <i>Picea Mariana</i> |
| Spruce, Norway * | 10 – 16" | 80' x 30' | Med | M | Fast | Great windbreak tree. Fastest spruce. <i>Picea abies</i> |
| Spruce, White | 8 – 18" | 60' x 25' | High | W - M | Med | Great windbreak tree. <i>Picea glauca</i> |
| Sumac, Staghorn | 12 – 18" | 7' x 4' | Low | M - D | Med | Excellent wildlife cover. <i>Rhus typhina</i> |
| Tamarack | 12 – 18" | 50' x 25' | Low | W - M | Fast | Deciduous. Golden in fall. Fastest conifer. <i>Larix laricina</i> |
| Willow, Golden * | 12 – 18" | 50' x 35' | Low | W - M | Fast | Upright, weeping form. <i>Salix alba var. vitelina</i> |

** W = Wet, M = Moderate, D = Dry. Most plants do best on moderate moisture & texture soils in full sunlight.

TREE MATS WITH STAPLES: 3 ft square. Comes with 5 staples each. Vispore Tree Mats act as a weed barrier, while allowing water to pass through. By reducing competition for water, the mats greatly increase survival & growth rates, as well as reduce vole damage to stems. Often best to kill grass before installing.

RIGID NET TUBES: 48" x 5". Includes two 5 foot stakes. Protects plants from deer & rabbits.

PLANTSKYDD ANIMAL REPELLENT: 2.2 lb. carton of soluble powder, stores well. Made of food-grade dried blood & vegetable oil. Will treat about 500 seedlings. Lasts about 4 months. Apply each spring & fall until plants are large enough to not need it.

BUD CAP NETTING: Each foot of tubing caps 2 trees. A flexible, stretchable net tube. Protects seedlings from browsing. Apply each fall until leader is out deer's reach. Works on broadleaves & conifers.
